to care for the needs of your Church/ in the Diocese of Wrexham.

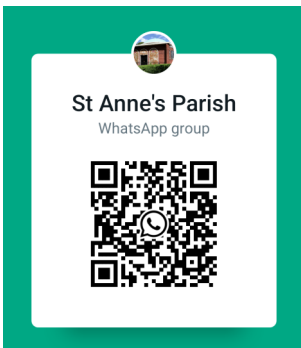
Through the intercession of Our Lady of Sorrow,/ pour out your Holy Spirit
